

# Starry Night

Clarksville's Starry Night is a 60' wide x 40' tall mural by artist Alasubomi Aka-Bashorun.

Depicting the influences of Vincent van Gogh, the mural showcases two iconic Clarksville spired buildings, the Customs House Museum & Cultural Center and the Montgomery County Courthouse beneath the distinctive starry night sky.

"We talked a lot at a local deli about things that the city would like, and accept, in a mural, and through talking with several different people, it came down to this theme that is being created," Aka-Bashorun told *The Leaf Chronicle*.

"Through the Starry Night creation I felt that it would be awesome for the buildings to seem to disappear into the nighttime skies, as daylight ended each day."

The project was funded by Two Rivers Company, a non-profit entity charged with the redevelopment of the downtown and Riverfront areas, along with private donations.
